### The Red Triangle Symbol

The Red Triangle symbol has been associated with the Y movement since its inception. The three equal sides of the triangle represent equal development of spirit, mind and body; a holistic approach. The bible, in the original design (shown at right) emphasizes the Y's value system founded on Christian principles.

- May have overcome physical, mental, spiritual, emotional or social-economic obstacles in order to provide leadership.
