2010 Counsellor-in-Training Application

History:

The Saint John YMCA-YWCA's Camp Glenburn has been involved in the camping industry for over 80 years. This long standing commitment to camping has allowed Camp Glenburn to establish its product into a reputable, successful, summer program. A large part of that reputation exists because of our well trained, caring and responsible staff members. The basis for our strong staff team is developed from our Counsellor- in- Training program, a program that was first developed over thirty years ago. Each summer, Camp Glenburn's campers and staff are offered the opportunity to engage in experiences that challenge perceived boundaries, enhance independence and promote teamwork.

The Program:

The Counsellor-In-Training (CIT) Program at Camp Glenburn is a comprehensive leadership development program for youth **aged 15 & 16**. The goal of the CIT program is to give each participant the tools and experiences necessary to be strong leaders. Skills developed during the cit summer become the foundation to life long successes. Each candidate selected for the CIT program has the opportunity to challenge themselves to reach new heights, both personally and as a part of a group. While living and working together for eight weeks, this team will develop a proficiency and certifications in skills such as: canoeing, kayaking, climbing, environmental education, drama, adventure-based programming, outdoor living skills, First Aid, CPR, out-tripping, and swimming.

The CIT program also offers participants an opportunity to develop communication and interpretive skills necessary to perform successfully in any team setting.

Many of the participants of the CIT program do become members of the Glenburn staff team; however, **completing the CIT program successfully does not guarantee future employment at Camp Glenburn.**

As a pre-requisite, we ask that all CITs begin the CIT program having already completed the Lifesaving Society's Bronze Medallion, Standard First Aid, and CPR level C. For more information please contact the Camp Glenburn office.

CIT dates and cost:

Program Begins: *10:00 am June 27, 2010*

Program Ends: *9:00 am on August 21, 2010*

Program Fee: *\$1,470.00 (not including H.S.T)*

The Selection process:

1. To apply, each candidate must fully complete and submit the CIT application to the Camp Glenburn office by:
Friday, April 16, 2010.

2. Applicants are then invited to the CIT Selection Weekend, which is a great opportunity for each applicant to come to Camp Glenburn and demonstrate their potential as a leader through a variety of activities and challenges. If candidates are not able to attend the Selection Weekend, please indicate this in the space provided on the application form, and an interview will be arranged prior to the weekend. Spaces may be held in one of our other summer programs until **June 11th**, whereupon a completed registration form must be received by the camp office.
