The Red Triangle Symbol

The Red Triangle symbol has been associated with the Y movement since its inception. The three equal sides of the triangle represent equal development of spirit, mind and body; a holistic approach. The bible, in the original design (shown at right) emphasizes the Y's value system founded on Christian principles.

The recipient of this award will have contributed to the furthering of the values and mission of the Saint John YMCA-YWCA and have enhanced the work of the Association and other charitable organizations or not-for-profits through philanthropy, giving of their time, talent and treasure, been an active volunteer and demonstrated community mindedness throughout their lifetime.

Leader to Watch Criteria

This individual of 35 years of age or less is a role model of skilled and enthusiastic leadership in an educational, family, career or community setting.

This individual is:

- Determined to lead, demonstrating their leadership at work, as a volunteer and at play;
- Is willing to act and support the constructive actions of others;
- Inspires and encourages other young people to take part in shaping the future of their community; and
- May have overcome physical, mental, spiritual, emotional or social-economic obstacles in order to provide leadership.
